**NAC Resolution No. 30**

Series of 2016

**Approving Amendments to NAC Resolution 13 on  
Handling of Compliance Verification in cases of State of Calamity, Disaster, Complexity  
and other Exceptional Cases**

Whereas, during the declaration of State of National Calamity, it is observed that the affected Field Offices have difficulty obtaining the necessary certifications from authorized agency/office/unit of required documents to invoke NAC Resolution 13;

Whereas, some of the reasons cited include the following: inaccessibility of the location of the authorized agency/office/unit, field staff are mobilized to help in the relief operations, field staff are also victims of the calamity.

Whereas, to address the issue, the members of the NAC, the highest policy making inter-agency body of Pantawid Pamilya, recognize the need to set the minimum required documents as well as the procedures to help the Field Offices in facilitating the request to invoke NAC Resolution 13 in areas under their jurisdictions which have been declared as under a State of National Calamity.

Now therefore, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the members of the NAC in a meeting held on 24 February 2016 to amend a.1 and a.2 under II. Procedures of NAC Resolution 13 as follows:

For a.1, add after the last sentence the provision that "In cases where the concerned DWSD Field Office is also drastically affected by a calamity which prevent them from facilitating a formal request to invoke NAC Resolution 13, the NPMO shall facilitate the request on their behalf."

For a.2, add a row for cases of multiple regions or provinces affected by calamity which necessitates the declaration of National State of Calamity in the first row of the table containing the recommended lists of certification and such that the first row will read as follows:

Cases	Certification Issued By	Remarks
Multiple regions or provinces are affected	President of the Philippines	For cases when a State of National Calamity is declared


