**NAC Resolution No. 31**  
Series of 2016

**Amending the Program Duration and Conditionalities of the Beneficiaries  
in the Modified Conditional Cash Transfer (MCCT) Program**

Whereas, to strengthen the implementation of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (P4), the NAC Resolution No. 6 provides for the "Adoption of a Modified Condition Cash Transfer Program under the Pantawid Pamilyang Program", the NAC Resolution No. 17 provides for the "Adoption of the Modified Conditional Cash Transfer under the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program to include responding to the situation of the Indigenous Peoples in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas", the NAC Resolution No. 19 provides for the "Additional Guidelines on the Implementation of the Modified Conditional Cash Transfer for Homeless Street Families" and, the NAC Resolution No. 21 also known as "Provision of Conditional Cash Grants to Additional 20,000 Target Households under Set 7", to respond to various characteristics of disadvantaged and vulnerable group of individuals, families and communities that at present is not directly addressed or responded to by the program.

Whereas, the Modified Conditional Cash Transfer Program clientele category are as follows:

- 1) Indigenous Peoples in geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas (IPs in GIDA)
- 2) Homeless Street Families (HSF)
- 3) Other Vulnerable Sectors (Families in Need of Special Protection FNSP)

Whereas, considering the complexity of the situations of indigenous peoples, homeless street families and families highly affected by disasters hinder the process of immediate transition into the Regular CCT.

Now therefore, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the members of the NAC in a meeting assembled on 24 February 2016 to approve the amendment in the program duration and conditionalities of NAC Resolutions No. 6, 17, 19 and 21 to state as follows:

***Program Duration<sup>1</sup>***

*The exposure of beneficiaries in the MCCT program shall be based upon the readiness of the beneficiaries and/or assessment of the worker for eventual mainstreaming to the Regular CCT.*

***Program Conditionalities<sup>2</sup>***

*For Homeless Families and Other Vulnerable Sectors (Families in Need of Special Protection FNSP)*

***A. Education***

- *Compliance verification to education to each child beneficiary in school commences on the **third month** from the date of registration.*

<sup>1</sup> The amendment to the Program Duration shall apply to the newly and existing registered beneficiaries.

<sup>2</sup> The amendment to the Program Conditionalities shall apply to the newly registered beneficiaries.

**B. Health**

- Compliance verification for Health grants shall commence on the **third month** from the date of registration in the program.

**C. Family Development Sessions**

- Compliance verification to Family Development Sessions shall commence on the **third month** upon registration.

**For MCCT-IP in GIDA Families**

**A. Education**

- Compliance verification to education to each child beneficiary in school commences on the **sixth month** from the date of registration.

**B. Health**

- Compliance verification for Health shall commence on the **sixth month** from the date of registration in the program.

**C. Community and Family Development Sessions**

- Compliance verification to Family Development Sessions shall commence on the **third month** upon registration.






