**REGULARITY OF RELEASE AND AMOUNT OF CONDITIONAL CASH
TRANSFER TO BENEFICIARIES OF
PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Republic Act 11310 or "An Act Institutionalizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program", otherwise known as the "4Ps Act" defines 4Ps as the national poverty reduction strategy and a human capital investment program that provides conditional cash transfer to poor households for a maximum of seven (7) years, to improve the health, education, and nutrition aspect of their lives.

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the the 4Ps Act assigns DSWD as the lead agency and shall serve as the central planning, coordinating, implementing, and monitoring body of the program. In the implementation of the 4Ps Act, the DSWD shall, among other functions, recommend to the National Advisory Council (NAC) measures and policies for the responsive delivery of the commitments under the 4Ps Act.

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the 4Ps Act states that the Advisory Council shall determine the amount of conditional cash transfer to the beneficiaries subject to the schemes provided.

WHEREAS, Section 39, Rule XVII of the 4Ps Act Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) states that the NAC shall be the policy-making body manifested through the approval of resolutions and enhancement of guidelines aimed towards ensuring supply side requirements and necessary support for household members to meet the conditions for entitlement and strengthening of overall implementation of the Program.

WHEREAS, Section 10, Rule VI of the 4Ps Act IRR provides that the Advisory Council shall determine the regularity and the amount of conditional cash transfer (CCT) to the beneficiaries through a resolution by the NAC as a policy-making body of the Program, subject to the schemes provided.

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the 4Ps Act provides that the amount necessary to carry out the provisions of the 4Ps Act shall be charged against those authorized in the current and subsequent General Appropriations Act.

WHEREAS, The 4Ps Act Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) was approved and signed on the 10th day of December 2019.


WHEREAS, There is an available amount of Php 2.6 Billion in the CY 2019 budget for cash grants that can be utilized for the December 2019 increase of cash grants.


WHEREAS, Republic Act 11465 or the General Appropriations Act of Fiscal Year 2020, provides the amount of One Hundred Eight Billion Seven Hundred Sixty Five Million Nine Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (P108,765,970,000) for 4Ps to support the poverty reduction and social development strategy of the National Government, of which the amount necessary to implement the new grant amounts as enumerated above was already factored in.

Now therefore, pursuant to the powers vested to the National Advisory Council it is RESOLVED as it is hereby resolved to promulgate the following rules relating to the regularity and amount of conditional cash transfer to Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program beneficiaries, to wit:


1. The conditional cash transfer shall be released every two months subject to the approved program timeline and verification of compliance to conditions as specified in Section 12. Rule VI of the 4Ps Act IRR;
2. The amount of conditional cash transfer shall be:
 - a. Three Hundred Pesos (Php300) per month per child enrolled in daycare and elementary programs for a maximum of ten (10) months per year ;
 - b. Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) per month per child enrolled in junior high school for a maximum of ten (10) months per year;
 - c. Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP700.00) per month per child enrolled in senior high school for a maximum of ten (10) months per year; and
 - d. Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP750.00) per month for a maximum of twelve (12) months per year for health and nutrition;
3. The amounts herein provided shall be effective starting Pay Period 6 of 2019 covering the months of December 2019 and January 2020 and shall continue to be in effect until the amounts are adjusted pursuant to in Section 26, Rule XI of the IRR of RA No. 11310.





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
