Executive Summary

The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) is the pioneer conditional cash transfer program implemented in 2008 by the national government with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) as the lead implementing agency. On April 17, 2019, 4Ps became a regular program of the national government thru the passage of Republic Act 11310 or “An Act Institutionalizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program”, or shortly “4Ps Act”. The law positions 4Ps as both a human capital development program and as the national poverty reduction strategy of the national government thru convergence with other pro-poor programs and services.

From January to November 2022 (Period 6B 2021 – Period 5 2022), a total amount of **PhP 89,807,178,000.00** cash grants were released and paid to about **4,343,267** households. Of this amount, **PhP29,554,779,600.00** is for the **education grants**, **PhP33,012,348,000.00** is for the **health grants**, and **PhP27,240,050,400.00** is for the **rice subsidy**. Rice subsidies are additional cash transfers provided on top of the 4Ps education and health grants since the year 2017 coming from the President’s State of the Nation Address in 2016.

Cash grants are delivered to 4Ps households through either cash cards or over-the-counter payments. As of the reporting period, **94.21%** of the total active households receive their grants through cash cards, while the remaining **5.79%** are through over-the-counter (OTC). Moreover, the program is continuously improving its payment modalities with a shift towards digital payments, especially during the pandemic period when close person-to-person transactions, such as OTC payouts, are discouraged. As of date, majority (**91.93%**) of the cash cards of the program beneficiaries are converted to basic deposit account.

As of 31 December 2022, the program covers a total of **3,798,151 active household beneficiaries** across 41,676 barangays in the entire country. This figure shows a **378,249 decrease** from last month’s count of active households, primarily attributed to on-going validation of poor and non-poor in Listahanan 3. The figure represents **86.32%** of the 4,400,000 target households based on the General Appropriations Act for the fiscal year 2022.

The program manages three major systems: the Beneficiary Updates System (BUS), the Compliance Verification System (CVS), and the Grievance Redress System (GRS). The BUS contains recent information on and updates to the status of household beneficiaries which serve as the basis for monitoring compliance to program conditions. A total of **661,171** updates have been encoded and approved in Period 5 (October - November) 2022. About three in every four (**73.78%**) updates are related to requests for update on their children’s education information.

Meanwhile, the CVS monitors and processes data on the compliance of household beneficiaries to the conditions set by the program, which, in turn, becomes the basis for the provision of cash grants. As of P5 2022, an average of **96.73%** health center visits was recorded to avail any of the health services offered. This include, but are not limited to, monthly weight monitoring, immunization, pre/post-natal check-ups. Likewise, **95.89%** have complied with the education condition of at least 85% school attendance; and **94.04%** have attended the monthly family development session.

The GRS keeps a record of the complaints received by the program through various modes such as, but not limited to, calls, grievance forms, social networking sites, and electronic mail. A total of **160,681 complaints** have been recorded as of the reporting period. Of these complaints, **144,666 (90.03%)** were already resolved. The GRS also monitors delisting and deactivation of households. As of this month, a total of **101,951** household beneficiaries have been delisted based on existing policies while **803,910** household beneficiaries have been deactivated.

In support of the vaccination campaign of the national government against COVID-19, the program has initiated the monitoring of vaccination among its beneficiaries. As of December 2022, the program has already vaccinated a total of **2,355,038 (57.86%)** out of the targeted **4,069,917** grantees aged 12 and above.

Further, in response to the fuel price hike during the 2nd quarter of the year, the Targeted Cash Transfer (TCT) program was introduced. It was operationalized through DSWD Memorandum Circular 9, series of 2022, or the “Special Guidelines for the Implementation of the Targeted Cash Transfer Program under the Protective Services for Individuals and Families in Especially Difficult Circumstances”. Section V provides that the scope of the TCT includes exactly **four million beneficiaries** under the 4Ps. Furthermore, Section IV provides that there should be a clean list of beneficiaries, which the 4Ps-NPMO endorsed to the Finance and Management Services (FMS) on **23 July 2022** for payroll processing.

Lastly, as stipulated in Rule XIII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act 11310, a total of **4,425,211 households** were endorsed to the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) on November 2022 for possible enrolment. As of **2nd Semester of 2022**, the PhilHealth reported a total of **214,506** beneficiaries availing their health insurance benefits with a corresponding amount of **PhP1,311,528,367.55**.

I. Geographic Coverage

Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program or 4Ps was first implemented in 2008 as the Philippines’ version of the conditional cash transfer program covering 160 cities and municipalities in 28 provinces in the 17 regions of the country. With the increase on the budget allocated to the program is its expansion in terms of geographical areas covered. As of 31 December 2022, the program has covered **41,676 barangays** in all **146 cities** and **1,481 municipalities** across **80 provinces** nationwide as shown in Table 1.

II. Household Coverage

The household beneficiaries of the program are being sourced from the Listahanan, or Listahan ng mga Sambahayang Nangangailan (List of Households “in Need”). The Listahanan serves as the national household targeting system (NHTS) for poverty reduction programs in the Philippines. In order to be eligible for 4Ps, the household should be among those identified by the Listahanan as poor or near poor, with a pregnant household member and/or with children 0-18 years old.

Since its inception, 4Ps has already served **5,544,832** poor households nationwide (see Table 2). **As of 31 December 2022, 4Ps are still serving 3,798,151 active household beneficiaries.** Others have already exited primarily due to no longer having a household member eligible for monitoring by the program and validated as no longer poor in Listahanan 3.

The figure represents **86.32%** of the 4,400,000 target households as provided for in the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2017 to 2022 and stipulated in the General Appropriations Act FY 2022. The program also covers specific marginalized groups such as **Itinerant Indigenous Peoples (Itinerant IPs), Homeless Street Families (HSF), Indigenous Peoples in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (IPs-GIDA) and Families in Need of Special Protection (FNSP)** due to natural and man-made calamities.

Table 3 presents the regional breakdown of the number of this year’s target and actual beneficiaries as of 31 December 2022. At the regional level, the highest percentages of the actual against the target number of 4Ps beneficiaries are in **Regions VI, Caraga, XI, MIMAROPA, and V** while the lowest percentages are from **Regions IV-A, CAR, III, IX, and NCR**.

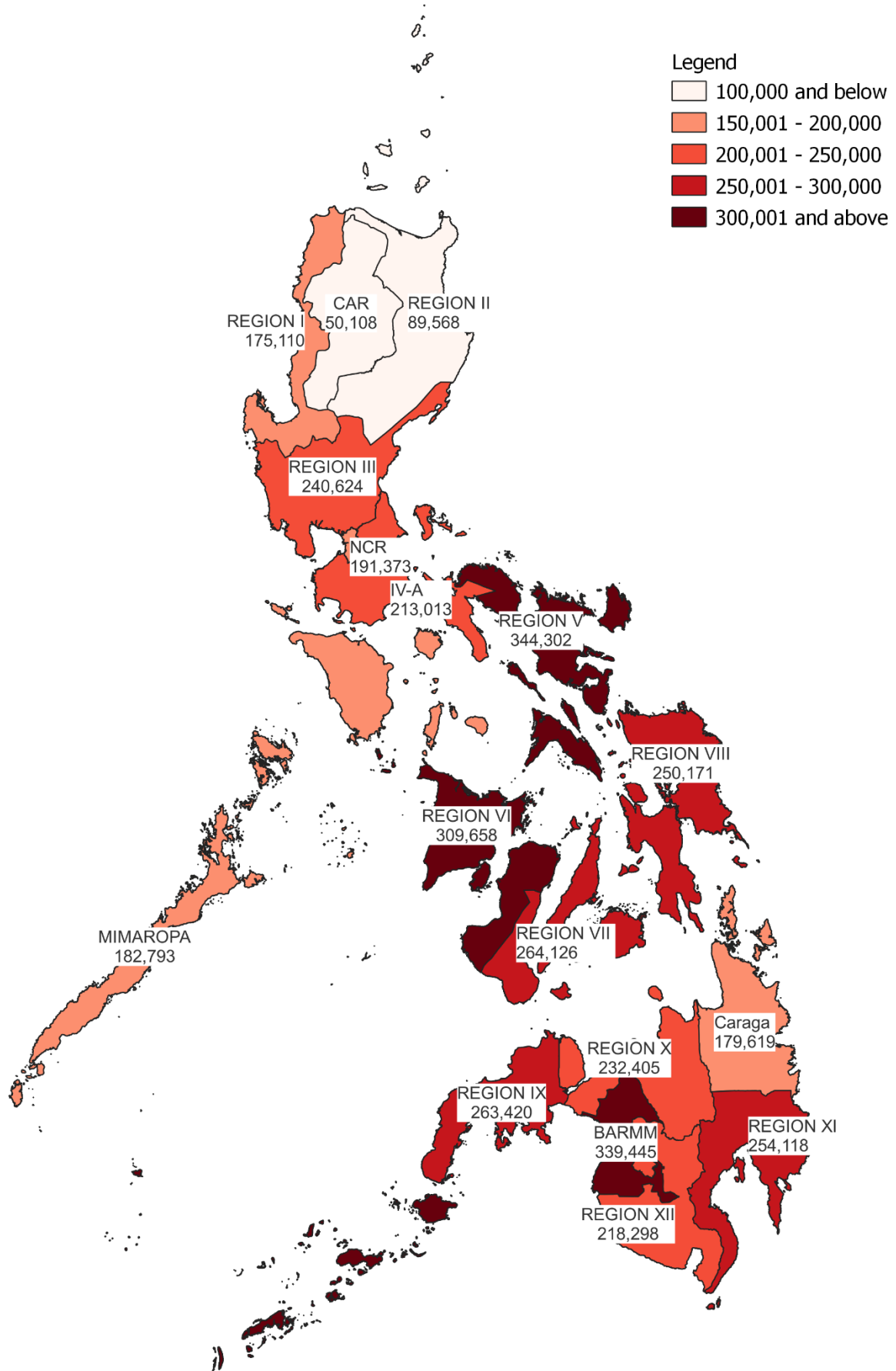

The current number of active 4Ps household beneficiaries shows a **decrease of 378,249 household beneficiaries** from the update in November 2022. Such decrease is primarily attributed to the ongoing validation of poor and non-poor households in Listahanan 3.

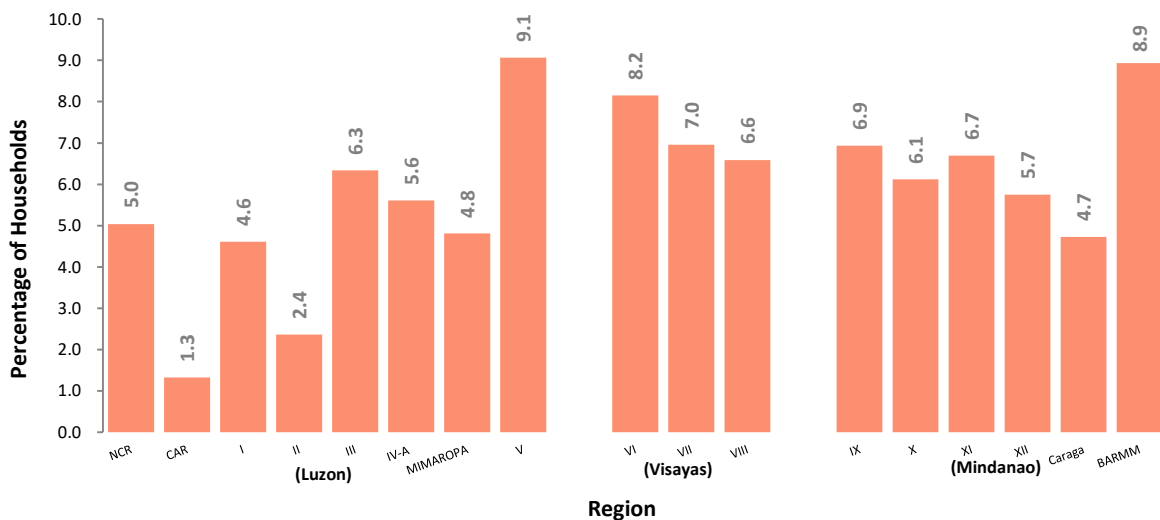
Further, most of the beneficiaries are from Mindanao with **1,487,305** or **39.16%** of the total households nationwide. This is followed by Luzon with **1,486,891** or **39.15%** of the total households nationwide. The Visayas, on the other hand, only has **823,955** household beneficiaries or **21.69%** of the nationwide total. Figure 1 illustrates the magnitude of actual beneficiaries by region as reflected in Table 3.

Moreover, Figure 2 shows the percentage distribution of active household beneficiaries by region. It can be noted that **Region V** has the highest number of active beneficiaries at **344,302** households, accounting for **9.06%** of the total number of active household beneficiaries nationwide. Also included in the Top 5 regions with the highest number of active 4Ps households are **BARMM**, with **339,445 (8.94%)** households; **Region VI**, with **309,658 (8.15%)** households; **Region VII** with **264,126 (6.95%)** households; and **Region IX** with **263,420 (6.94%)** households. On the other hand, **CAR** has the least number of active 4Ps household beneficiaries, with **50,108** households only or **1.32%** of the total active households nationwide. This is followed by **Region II** with **89,568 (2.36%)** households; **Region I** with **175,110 (4.61%)** households; **Caraga** with **179,619 (4.73%)** households; and **MIMAROPA**, with **182,793 (4.81%)** households.

Looking at the vulnerable marginalized groups in Table 4, the majority of the beneficiaries belong to the **IPs-GIDA** with **153,003** households accounting for **84.90%** of the total number of active 4Ps household beneficiaries among vulnerable groups nationwide. The **IPs-GIDA** are mostly coming from Mindanao, particularly in **BARMM** with **27,687** households; **Regions XI** with **24,982** households; and **Region IX** with **19,015** households.

Further, the **FNSP** account for **13.12%** or **23,647** household beneficiaries of the total household beneficiaries among vulnerable groups nationwide. The majority of the **FNSPs** are coming from **Region VIII** with **12,185** households, and **Region VII** with **9,534** households.

Furthermore, most of the **HSF** come from **NCR** with **2,341** households, accounting for only **1.81%** or **3,265** households of the total 4Ps household beneficiaries among vulnerable groups nationwide. Only **304** households are classified as **Itinerant IPs**, which covers **0.17%** of the total households in the vulnerable sector.

III. Household Profile

A. Grantees

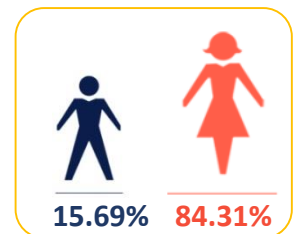


Figure 3. Percentage of Male and Female Grantees in the Program

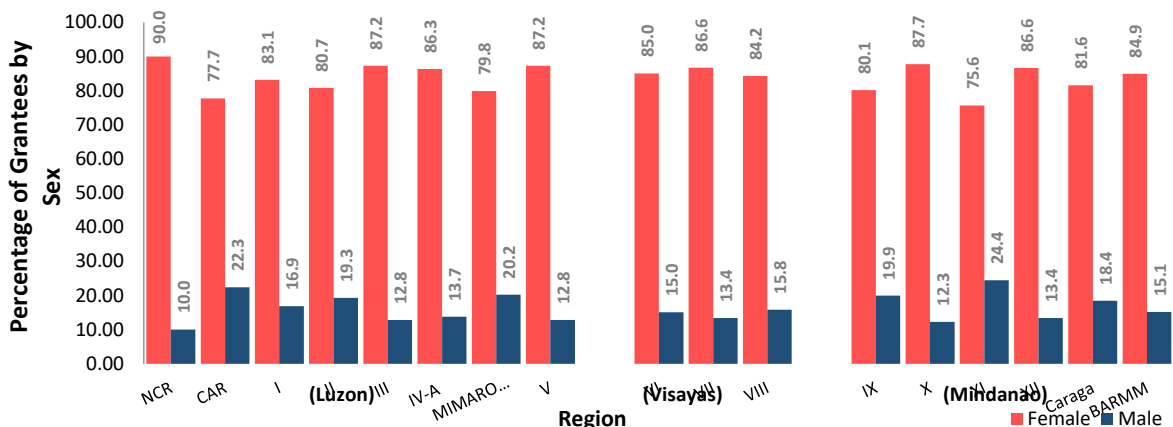


Figure 4. Percentage of Male and Female Grantees within Each Regions

Grantee refers to the household member authorized to withdraw or receive the grants from the Program. Figure 3 shows the percentage of male and female grantees. The Program currently has more female grantees than male grantees. There are **3,202,040 female grantees** or **84.31%** and **596,111 male grantees** or **15.69%** of the total active household beneficiaries nationwide. Based on regional data in Figure 4, **NCR** has the highest percentages of female grantees at **89.97%** while **CAR** has the lowest at **77.67%**. As such, **NCR** has the lowest percentage of male grantees at **10.03%**, while **CAR** has highest percentage at **22.33%** respectively.

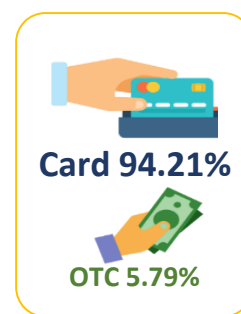


Figure 5. Percentage of Grantees by Mode of Payment

Figure 5 shows the national distribution of grantees according to their mode of payment (MOP). Of the **3,798,151** active households, **3,578,189 (94.21%) households receive their grants via cash card**; the remaining **219,962 (5.79%)** household's avail over-the-counter payments.

Table 5 presents the regional breakdown of the above figures. It can be observed that the percentages of cash card holders per region vary. Nonetheless, all regions have higher percentage of cash card holders than those claiming grants over the counter.

Of these 17 regions, **Region I** has almost saturated the use of cash card as MOP to all its beneficiaries, covering **99.56%** of its household beneficiaries. This is followed by **Region VI (98.37%)**, **Region II (98.09%)**, **Region III (97.49%)**, and **MIMAROPA (97.07%)**.

B. Household Head

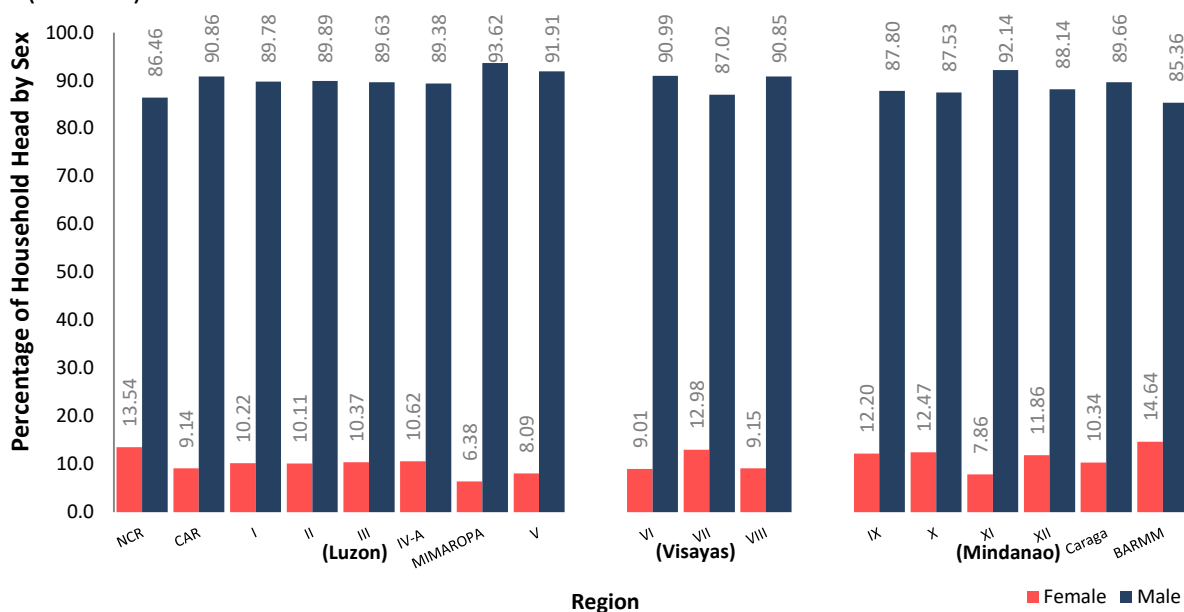


Figure 6. Percentage of Male and Female Household Head by Region

The head of the household is an adult person, male or female, who is responsible for the organization and care of the household, who is regarded as such by the members of the household³. Majority of the 4Ps households are male-headed (**89.33%**). Figure 6 shows the percentage of male and female household heads by region. Among the 17 regions, **BARMM** has the highest percentage of female-headed households (**14.64%**). Following this are **NCR (13.54%)**, **Region VII (12.98%)**, **Region X (12.47%)**, and **Region IX (12.20%)**.

C. Children

Table 6 presents the number of Pantawid Pamilya children⁴ by region and age group. Overall, Pantawid Pamilya is covering **7,335,377 eligible children** 0 to 18 years old⁵ nationwide. Most of these eligible children come from **Region V** accounting for **736,512 children** or **10.04%** of the total number of eligible children nationwide. Also included in the Top 5 regions with the highest number of eligible children are **Region VI** with **632,176 children (8.62%)**; **BARMM** with **594,546 children (8.11%)**; **Region VII** with **543,300 children (7.41%)**; and **Region VIII** with **481,596 children (6.57%)**. Regions **CAR**, **Region II**, and **Caraga** are the bottom 3 regions in terms of child coverage. **CAR** has **98,269 children (1.34%)**; **Region II** has **175,650 children (2.39%)**; and **Caraga** has **339,315 children (4.63%)**.

In terms of age brackets, more than half of them are **6 to 14 years old**, accounting for **3,818,149** or **52.08%** of the total number of eligible children nationwide. This is followed by those in the **15-to-18-year-old** age group with **3,223,847 children (43.98%)**. There are only a few children that fall under the 0 to 2-year-old and the 3 to 5-year-old age brackets. The **3 to 5-year-old** age group only has **233,532 (3.19%)** and the remaining **56,270** children are within the **0 to 2-year-old** age bracket accounting for only for **0.77%** of the total number of eligible children.

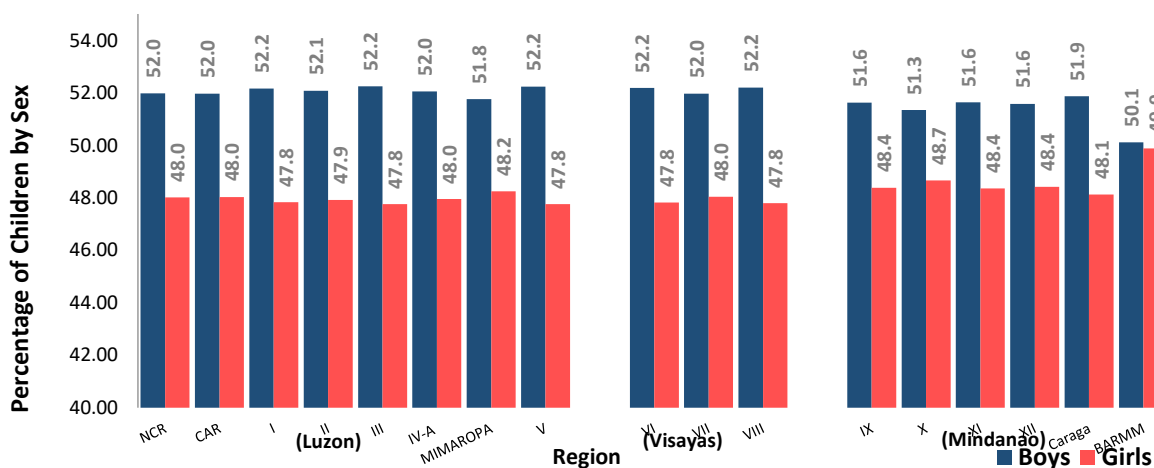


Figure 7. Percentage of Boys and Girls (Children) within Each Region

Figure 7 shows the percentage of boys and girls (children) within each region. **Region III** has the highest proportion of boys (**52.25 %**), while **BARMM** has the lowest (**50.12%**).

Table 7 shows the distribution of children by grade level. Most of the children monitored by the program are in **Grades 7 to 10 (Junior High School)** accounting for **2,907,282** children (**39.65%**). This is followed by children in **Grades 1 to 6 (Primary Education)** accounting for **2,586,224** children or **33.45%** of the total number of monitored children. Lastly, **1,095,809** children are in **Grades 11-12 or Senior High School** representing **14.95%** of the total number of Pantawid Pamilya children nationwide.

Further, there are **648,246 children in Grade 6**, or **8.84%** of the total number of children covered by the program expected to move up to Junior High School. Another **953,102 children in Grade 10 (13.00%)** are expected to move up to Senior High School; while **461,210 children in Grade 12 (6.29%)** are expected to complete basic education and pursue college degrees.

Table 8 shows the distribution of children enrolled under the regular curriculum of Elementary (Grades 1-6), Junior and Senior High School (Grades 7-12), and in ADM/ALS. Of the total number of children enrolled in Grades 1-12, **6,420,237 children (99.45%)** are under regular curriculum, while the remaining **35,650 children (0.55%)** are under ADM/ALS. Moreover, of the total number of children 6-14 years old, there are about **8,754 children (0.14%)** enrolled in Elementary ADM/ALS. Most of whom are from **Regions MIMAROPA, VI, X, V, II**, and; about **26,896 children (0.42%)** are enrolled in secondary ADM/ALS, and most of whom are from **Regions V, VI, MIMAROPA, III**, and **VII**.

Table 9 presents the age group and sex of children by grade level. For children in **Kindergarten**, **209,321** out of **374,001 (55.97%)** children are within the 6 to 14-year-old age group and there is no pronounced sex variance. For **Grades 1-6**, **2,057,138** out of **2,452,796 (83.87%)** children are within the 6 to 14-year-old age group, and the majority of them are boys at about **53.52%**. For **Junior High School (Grades 7-10)**, **1,577,678** out of **2,907,282 (54.27%)** children belong to the 15 to 18-year-old age group, with no pronounced sex variance. For **Senior High School (Grades 11-12)**, all **1,095,809** children are within the 15 to 18-year-old age group and **53.85%** are girls.

D. Elderly Member

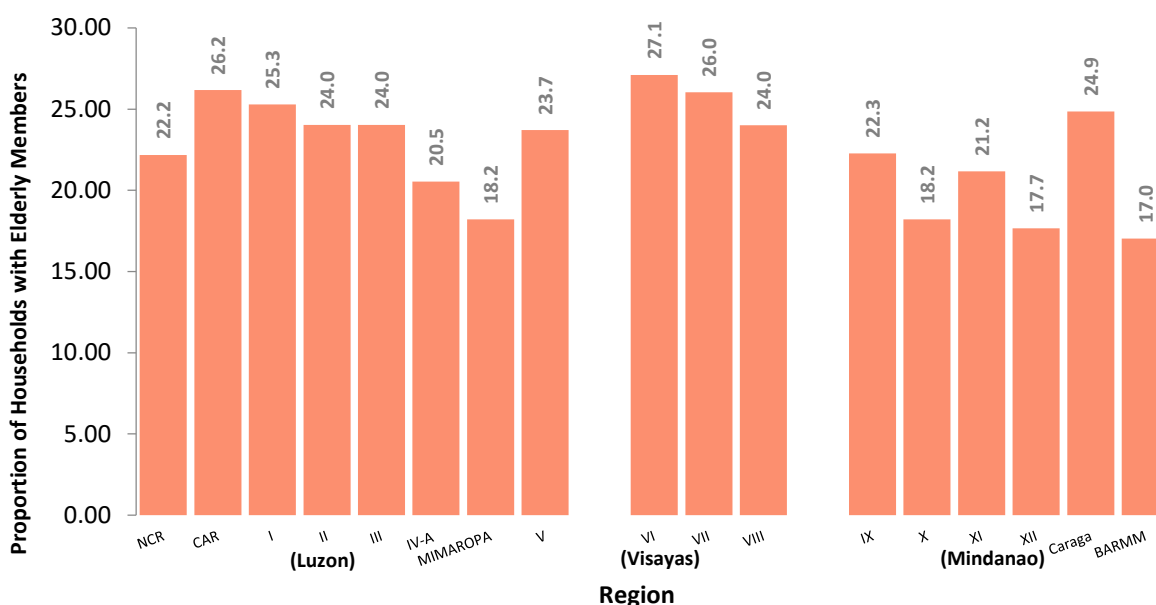


Figure 8. Percent Distribution of Households Beneficiaries with Elderly Member by Region

Older people, elderly, or senior citizen is defined as individuals belonging to the age group 60 years and over⁶. As of 31 December 2022, Figure 8 illustrate that there are **846,286** households that have at least one (1) elderly member. This represents **18.22%** of the total 3,798,151 households. At the regional level, **Region VI** has the highest percentage of households with elderly members at **27.10%** (83,908 out of 309,658). This is followed by **CAR (26.17%)**, **Region VII (26.04%)**, **Region I (25.28%)**, and **Caraga (24.86%)**. Meanwhile, **BARMM** has the lowest percentage at **17.02%** (57,790 out of 339,445).

Table 10 shows its regional breakdown by age group and sex. As of 31 December 2022, there are **1,175,845** elderly members among active 4Ps households. Among regions, **Region VI** has the highest percentage of elderly members (**10.16%**). This is followed by **Region V (9.91%)**, **Region VII (8.39%)**, **Region VIII (7.30%)**, and **Region IX (6.96%)**. In terms of sex, more than half are **males (55.03%)**, while the remaining are **females (44.97%)**. Lastly, based on their age, most of them are aged **60 to 69 years old (61.88%)**. Following this are **70 to 79 years old (26.06%)**, **80 to 89 years old (10.60%)**, and **90 years old and above (1.47%)**.

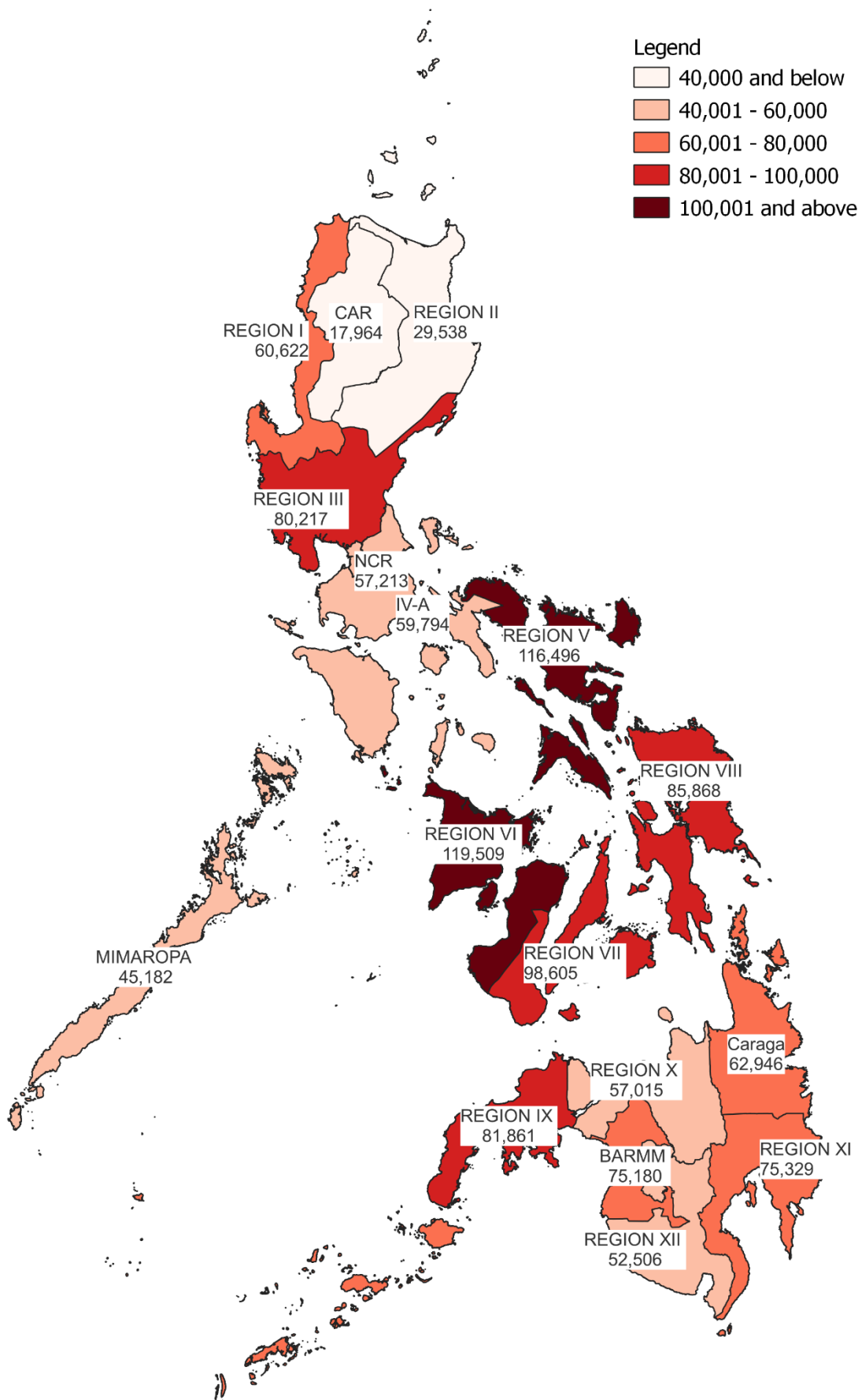

Old dependency ratio is the ratio of persons in the old “dependent” ages (over 64 years) to persons in the “working” ages (15 to 64 years).⁷ As of 31 December 2022, the old dependency ratio is 4 which means that for every 100 persons aged 15 to 64 years, there are about 4 dependents aged 65 years and older. Figure 9 illuminates the scale of elderly distribution within 4Ps households in the country.

E. Indigenous People

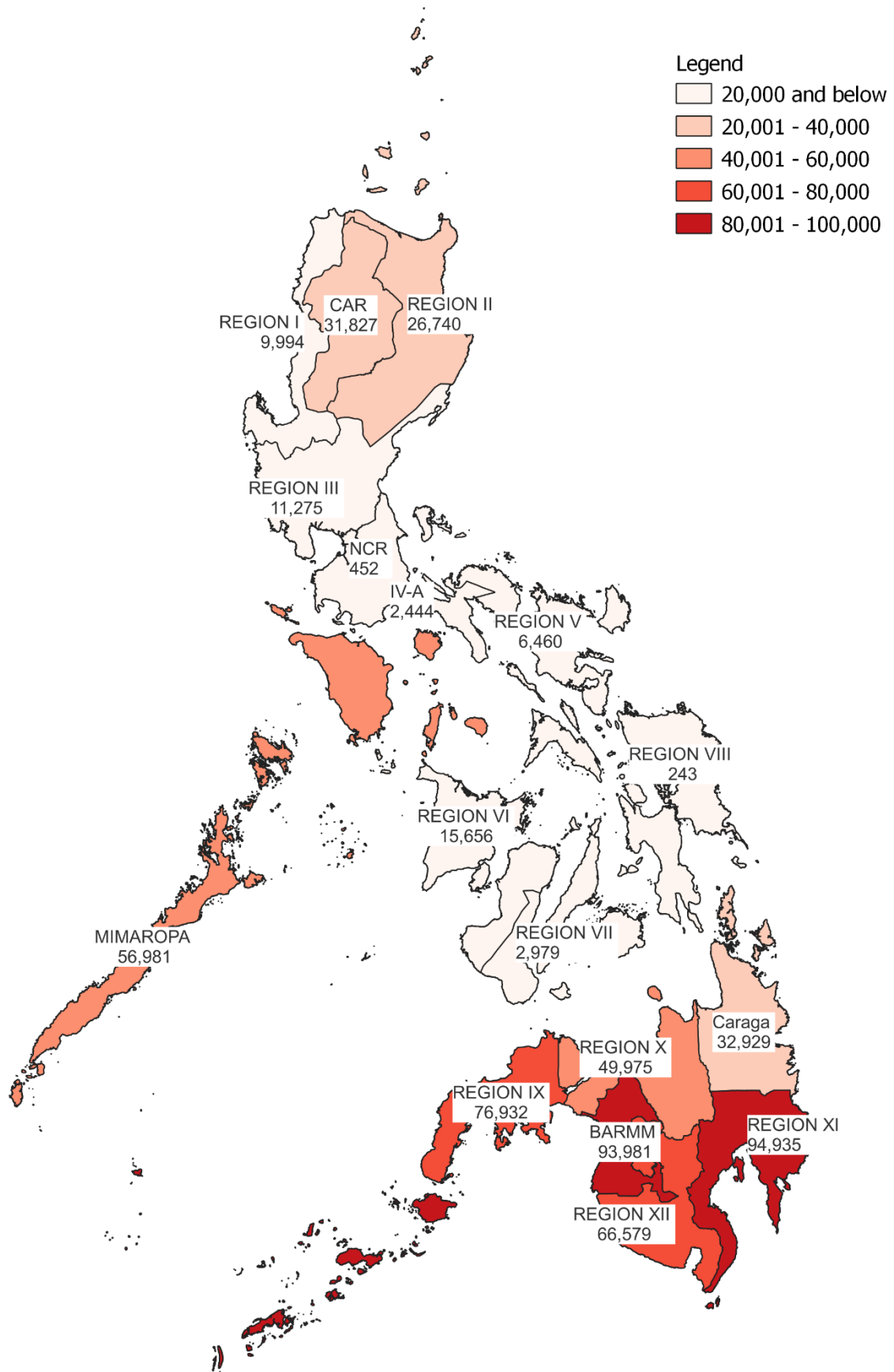
Table 11 presents the regional breakdown of IP households and household members. Out of the **3,798,151** households, **580,382 (15.28%)** are **Indigenous Peoples, with – 415,331 (71.56%)** households coming from **Mindanao**; **146,173 (25.19%)** from **Luzon**; and **18,878 (3.25%)**, from **Visayas**.

Moreover, across regions, **Region XI** has the highest number of IPs households and household members, accounting for **94,935 (16.36%)** households with **499,551 (15.79%)** household members. This is followed by **BARMM** with **93,981** households (**16.19%**) and **500,841 (15.83%)** household members; and **Region IX** with **76,932** households (**13.26%**) and **398,286** household members (**12.59%**). Figure 10 illustrates the magnitude of IP households in the country.

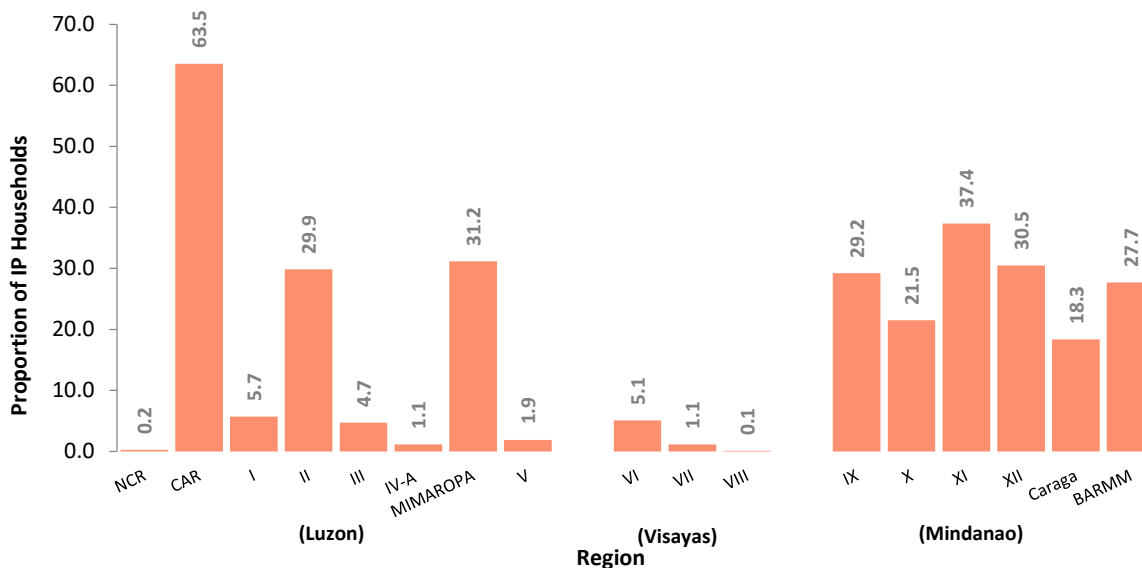


Figure 11. Proportion of IP Household in the Program by Region

Based on the percentage of IP households by region as shown in Figure 11, **CAR** has the highest share, representing **63.52%** of its total household beneficiaries. Meanwhile, **Region VIII** has the lowest share with only **0.10%** that are IPs. Figure 11 further illustrates the magnitude of IPs by region.

Table 12 shows the top ten IP groups with the greatest number of IP households in the program. Most of the IP households are **Manobo** accounting for **104,261 (17.96%)** IP household beneficiaries. This is followed by the **Subanon (16.24%)**, **Sama (14.51%)**, **Tinguian-Itneg (8.87%)**, **Higaonon (7.73%)**, and **Yakan (7.03%)**. Also included are **B'Laan (6.63%)**, **Iraya (4.13%)**, **Maguindanaon (3.48%)**, and **Tagbanua (2.29%)**. The remaining **11.49%** comprise of at least 171 other groups.

F. Households with Persons with Disability (PWDs)⁸

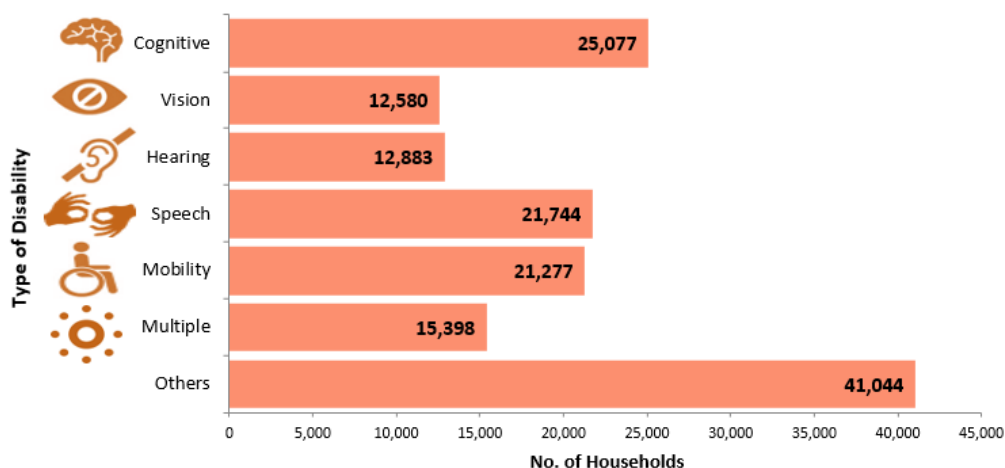


Figure 12. Type of Disabilities Among Pantawid Pamilya Households with PWDs

The program is also accounting for the number of households with at least one member classified as person with disability (PWD). Out of the total 3,798,151 Pantawid households, **150,003 (3.95%)** households are with PWDs. Figure 12 then presents that most of these have household members with mental disabilities at **25,077** cases; followed by those with speech disabilities at **21,744** cases, and those with other disabilities at **41,044** cases.

G. Solo Parents

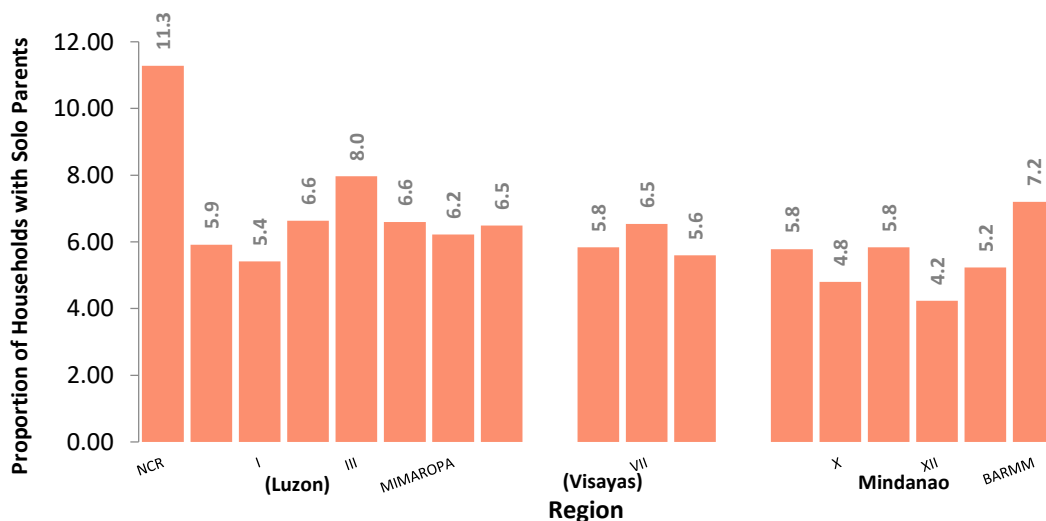
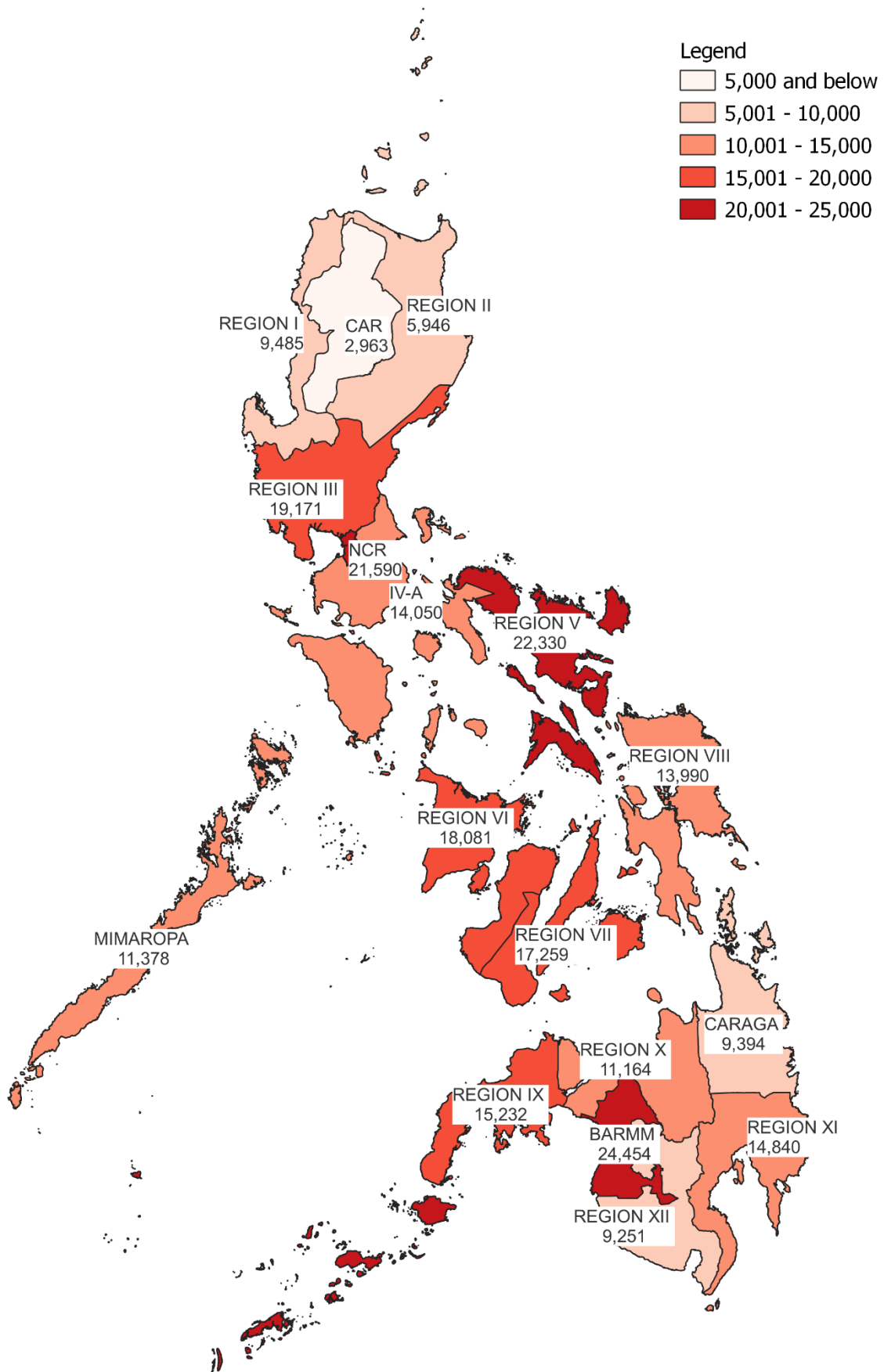


Figure 13. Percent Distribution of Household Beneficiaries with Solo Parents by Region

Republic Act No. 8972, or the “Solo Parents Welfare Act of 2000” recognizes solo parents as part of the disadvantaged sector in the Philippines. As of 31 December 2022, there are **240,578** households with solo parent member/s in the program, representing **6.33%** of the Pantawid Pamilya households nationwide. At the regional level, **NCR** has the biggest percentage of solo parents at **11.28%** (21,590 out of 191,373 households) as reflected in Figure 13 below. **Region XII**, on the other hand, has the least percentage with only **4.15%** or 9,251 out of 218,298 households. Figure 14 illustrates the magnitude of households with solo parents nationwide.

Looking at the individual level, Table 13 shows the regional breakdown of the number of solo parent household members disaggregated by age group and sex. Of the total **291,830** solo parent household members, **195,116 (66.86%)** are **females**, while the remaining **96,714 (31.14%)** are **males**. In terms of age, most of them are from the older age group, **46 years old and above (40.67%)**. At the regional level, **BARMM** has the highest percentage of solo parents with **37,171** household members (**12.74%**). This is followed by **Region V (9.23%)**, **NCR (9.22%)**, **Region III (7.92%)**, and **Region IX (6.82%)**.

H. Pregnant Members

As of 31 December 2022, there are **15,786** pregnant household members of 4Ps households. Table 14 presents its breakdown by region and age group. It can be observed that most of them are aged 26 to 35 years old (**47.91%**). This is followed by 36 to 45 years old (**29.36%**), and 16 to 25 years old (**15.11%**). The remaining are 46 years old and above (**5.71%**), and 15 years old and below (**1.91%**). In terms of geographic location, majority of them are from Mindanao (**72.70%**) – most of whom are from **BARMM (32.79%)**, **Region XI (11.79%)**, and **Region XII (8.33%)**. Meanwhile, a minority are from **Region VI (1.24%)**, **CAR (1.03%)**, and **Region II (0.73%)**.

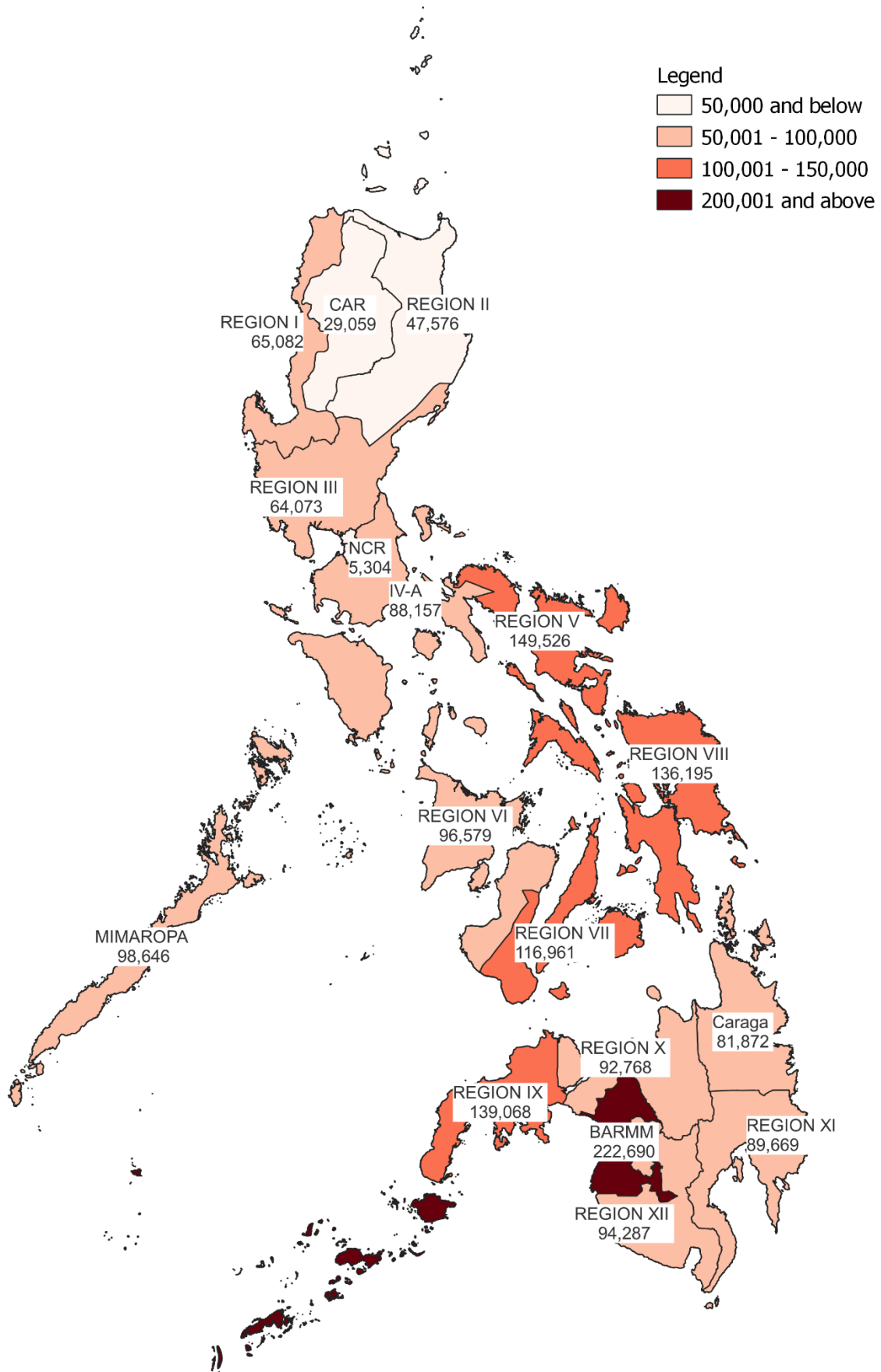

I. Households Engaged in Farming, Fishing, and/or Forestry

Out of the **3,798,151** Pantawid households, about **1,471,263 (38.74%)** households have at least one member engaged in farming, fishing, and/or forestry. Of this figure, **691,945 (47.03%)** households are from **Mindanao**. This leaves **462,073 (31.41%)** households to **Luzon**; and **317,245 (21.56404.%)** households to **Visayas**. Figure 15 shows its distribution by region.

Lastly, households not engaged in farming, which comprises the other half of the household population are government and private employees, practicing professionals, technicians and associate professionals, clerks, service and/or shops and market sales workers, trades and related workers, plant and machine operators and assemblers, laborers, and unskilled workers. Figure 15 illustrates the magnitude of households with farmers, fisherfolks and/or foresters in the country.

IV. Grants Released

From January 2022, the total amount of cash grants released is **PhP89,807,178,000.00** and paid to a total of about **4,343,267** 4Ps household beneficiaries. Of this amount, **PhP29,554,779,600.00** is for **education grants**, **PhP33,012,348,000.00** is for **health grants** and **PhP27,240,050,400.00** is for **rice subsidy**.

In an effort to continuously improve the delivery of grants, the Department, through the Land Bank of the Philippines, is engaging other service providers such as local rural banks, and cooperatives as partner conduits. Table 15 below shows the distribution of cash grants based on available payment modes.

V. Systems and Updates

A. Beneficiary Updates System (BUS)

The BUS records changes on the status or condition of households. It captures recent information about household members to serve as basis in monitoring the compliance of beneficiaries. Updating is a continuous process to ensure that beneficiaries are availing the maximum health and education grants.

As of Period 5 (October to November) 2022, a total of **661,171** updates were encoded and approved. The breakdown of the total number of updates per region is shown in Table 16. **BARMM** has the highest turnout of updates of beneficiaries for the current period with a total of **69,195** updates. Also in the Top 5 regions with the highest number of updates are **Region X (60,808)**, **Region VI (54,080)**, **Region V (52,349)**, and **Region XI (51,619)**.

B. Compliance Verification System (CVS)

The CVS monitors the compliance of households with the conditions of the program as basis for the provision of grants. Table 18 on one hand below shows the distribution of monitored children by sex, IP affiliation, age group and program condition. As of P5 2022, there are **6,615,836** 0 to 18 years old children monitored for education and/or health conditions. Among these monitored children, 51.19% are boys while 48.81% are girls. Moreover, of the total children monitored, only 14.50% are identified as part of the IP community.

Table 19 shows the compliance rate of household by program condition as of P5 2022. In general, 96.73% visited the health center to avail any of the health services offered which include, but not limited to, monthly weight monitoring, immunization, pre/post-natal check-ups; 95.89%, on the average, complied with the education condition of at least 85% school attendance; and 94.04% attended the monthly family development session.

C. Grievance Redress System (GRS)

As of December 2022, a total of **160,681** complaints were encoded and recorded in the GRS through various modes such as calls, grievance forms, social networking sites, couriers, and electronic mail. Of these encoded grievances, **144,666 (90.03%)** have been resolved.

Based on Figure 16, **Luzon** has the highest percentage of grievance encoded and recorded at **70.87%**. This is followed by **Mindanao** with **17.66%**, and **Visayas** with **11.47%**. Regional data in Table 21 shows that the regions with the highest number of grievances are from **MIMAROPA (35.83%)**, **Region V (8.90%)**, **NCR (7.56%)**, **Region VI-A (5.93%)**, and **Region IX (5.49%)**. Whereas, **Region X (1.66%)** and **CAR (1.29%)** have the least number of grievances encoded and recorded

Out of the **160,681** grievances, **37,249 (23.18%)** grievance fall under withholding of grants due to Inclusion Request issue which comprises the highest number of filed

complaints as shown in Table 22. Under Others category, it is specifically due to the on-going validation of poor and non-poor in Listahanan 3.

The GRS displays the total number of delisted and deactivated households since 2009. As of 31 December 2022, **101,951** household beneficiaries have been delisted based on existing policies, and another **803,910** household beneficiaries have been deactivated and are pending for validation of field offices. Deactivated households are households whose status as program beneficiaries are suspended either due to inconsistencies in data, on-going validation process, or other issues of the households. Delisted households, on the other hand, are households that have been removed from the program due to any of the following reasons: fraudulent acts, inclusion error, and household waived their inclusion into the program. The total number of delisted and deactivated household by category is provided below in Table 23.

VI. Human Resource

In Table 24 shows that a total of 14,138 technical and administrative positions assigned at the National and Regional Offices (including personnel assigned at the covered provinces and cities/municipalities) have been approved for the program. As of latest update, **13,746** personnel have been hired (95.32% of the total number of approved positions). Of this total number of hired personnel, **11,663** or **86.55%** are hired for contractual position.

VII. Other Accomplishments/Updates

A. Partnership and Collaboration with National Government Agencies

Partnership with Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth). The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation and Department of Social Welfare and Development formalized its partnership through a Joint Order signed on November 6, 2012. The partnership aims to provide healthcare to poor household identified by the National Household Targeting System (NHTS) and beneficiaries under the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program. In 2012, all Pantawid Pamilya beneficiaries were enrolled under the sponsorship program for indigent. The program expanded and covered MCCT beneficiaries on 2015. The beneficiaries both MCCT and RCCT were provided MDR and may use their Pantawid Pamilya identification card to avail health care benefits to PhilHealth Accredited hospitals and clinics. The Pantawid Pamilya is endorsing the names of Pantawid beneficiaries to PhilHealth for enrollment in their database every 4th quarter of the year. This includes the beneficiaries whose grants were put on hold but are still eligible to receive grants. As of November 2021, 4Ps has endorsed a total of **4,506,531** households for enrolment to 2021 Indigent Program of PhilHealth.

As of 2nd Quarter of 2022, the PhilHealth reported a total of **214,506** beneficiaries who have availed health insurance benefits with a corresponding amount of **PhP1,311,528,367.55**. Across regions, Region III reflected the highest number of beneficiaries availed health insurance with **20,687** which yielded a total amount of **PhP136,120,698.84** as shown in Table 24.

Partnership with Civil Society Organization. Partnership of DSWD with NGOs, CSOs and the private sectors are aimed to strengthen the well-being of qualified beneficiaries. It shall promote participation and involvement in community development. Partnership engagement includes program complementation, service delivery, capacity building, knowledge management, and advocacy and sponsorships. As of July 2022 update, a total of 724 CSO volunteer partners were engaged in Pantawid Pamilya.

B. COVID-19 Vaccination among Pantawid Beneficiaries

In support to the vaccination campaign of the national government against COVID-19, the program monitors the progress of vaccination among its beneficiaries. As of 31 December 2022, the program has reported a total of **2,355,038 (57.86%)** grantees already vaccinated as shown in Table 25 below.

Moreover, 12 out of the 17 regions have already reached at least 50% of their targets with **Region IV-A** having the most number of vaccinated grantees at **255,363 (82.85%)**; followed by **Region I** with **138,570 (71.04%)**; and **BARMM** with **237,116 (66.08%)**.

C. Other Accomplishments/Updates

Endorsement of 4Ps beneficiaries for Inclusion to the Targeted Cash Transfer (TCT).

The TCT project is operationalized through DSWD Memorandum Circular 9, series of 2022, “Special Guidelines for the Implementation of the Targeted Cash Transfer Program under the Protective Services for Individuals and Families in Especially Difficult Circumstances.” This project is designed to cushion the impact of the rising fuel prices to the bottom 12.4 million poor families nationwide, of which 4 million are from the 4Ps. Given this, the 4Ps-NPMO was able to endorse a clean list of **4 million households** for inclusion in the TCT on **23 July 2022**.

Provision of Micro-Enterprise Development through Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP).

As of July 2022, a total of 1,856 Pantawid Pamilya households were referred to and funded by Micro-Finance Institutions and other formal lending institutions.

Livelihood Assistance Grants (LAG).

LAG was provided to low-income families in the informal sector whose livelihood or jobs were affected by the imposition of community quarantine or are assessed to be continuously affected. As of July 2022, 6,144 Pantawid Pamilya households were provided with LAG through microenterprise development track and employment facilitation.
